### A Message from the DEI Committee Chair Nichole Doye-Battle

In late 2020, the MAHC Board of Directors created a permanent Diversity Equity Inclusion (DEI) Committee and updated the MAHC Mission Statement to reflect MAHC's diversity priorities. The purpose of the new DEI Committee is to look at MAHC's work through a DEI lens and to create, promote, and provide learning opportunities that will help members to be more diverse, inclusive, and equitable and to gain a better understanding of the history and disparities that exist in the affordable housing industry. We recently hired the Maryland-based consulting firm hyrUP to lead us in this effort. The consultant will lead a strategic planning session with the MAHC Board in June to ensure that our Board, and the Coalition's future work, is inclusive and promotes diversity, while also providing opportunities to grow future leaders in the affordable housing industry.

The DEI Committee has created an Action Plan which includes both short term and long term implementation steps. The Committee will continue to review and monitor our current policies and procedures while promoting practices that are more equitable and representative of the communities we serve. 

## Draft Anne Arundel County Action Plan Available for Comment

Anne Arundel County's draft Annual Action Plan for fiscal year 2022 is now available for public review and comment. The document presents a detailed strategy for the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) and Continuum of Care (COC) funds expected to be received by the County during the year.

### WHAT'S GOING ON AT MARYLAND DHCD

### **Assisted Housing Relief Program Relaunch**

DHCD has set aside \$40 million to relaunch the Assisted Housing Relief Program (AHRP), which serves rental units in multifamily projects financed by DHCD's Community Development Administration using state funds and other federal resources. The program is expected to open on May 17, 2021 and will cover overdue rents for eligible tenants for calendar year 2021.
